The Fire Board of the Verde Valley Fire District will meet in regular session on **Tuesday, October 27, 2020 at 3:00 p.m.** The meeting will be held in the Board Room at Station 31, located at 2700 E. Godard Road, Cottonwood, Arizona. The Board may vote to go into executive session on any agenda item, pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3) for legal advice with the District's attorney on matters as set forth in the agenda item. Board Members or other participants may attend by electronically or telephonically. The following topics, and any variables thereto, will be subject to Board consideration, discussion, approval, or other action. All items are set for possible action.
